Day-Old Chickens?!

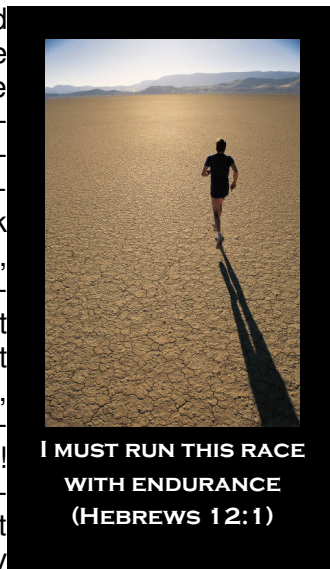
