"I see what I told my church... and many things were wrong!" For eleven years Jessie was a pastor in the Solomon Islands and during that time he saw the need for Bible training. His church sent him to CLTC and after three years in the classroom, and another on internship, Jessie graduated with his Diploma of Theology degree. He told me, "Now I am going back to tell my people what is true!"

His story is not unusual. Many students here have been in ministry for years, preaching and teaching to hundreds or even thousands of people, all without any formal Bible training! What this part of the world needs more than anything else are leaders grounded in God's word. Jessie is home for Christmas and he is teaching the truth!
