The Issue is Why!

"They say you must be cleanshaven, and wear a white shirt and black trousers. What will I say to them?" As we were finishing laying the groundwork to the book of Galatians and discussing the issue of adding something anything—to the gospel, a student asked this question. I said to ask them, "Why?" If they say it is something you must do to be a Christian, they are false teachers. If they say it is something you must do to be a good Christian, they are legalists. If they say it is a way to get God to do something for them, they are animists. And, if they say it is something they do to make God happy with them, they are believing another gospel. However, if they say they do it just because they love God, that's the right answer!

It seems like every church out there, even the "good" ones, are adding something to the gospel.



What they learn from this study of Galatians will transform their lives and their ministry!

You can't drink, you can't smoke, you must belong to our church, you must speak in tongues. Even, you must wear a white shirt and black trousers (shoes are optional)!

These students will graduate in November and return to their churches; almost every one will have to battle this issue. The only way they can win is through God's strength and sound teaching!
