

David, our single Samoan student, is on his way home to do just that. He is a dedicated student and he learns quickly. He is also a gifted teacher, so much so that we have asked him to consider coming back to CLTC - this time as a lecturer!



Among these Diploma of Theology graduates are pastors, youth workers and Bible school teachers. In a country where there are few jobs, there is much work to be done!
