On Sunday, October 16th Hans preached in church. On Monday he became ill and Tuesday at 2 PM, he died. Last February, when we first started looking for where God wanted us to serve Him next, it was Hans Lane — the Dean of Studies at Christian Leaders Training College (CLTC) — who took my name to the president.
