Unscheduled Furlough

As you read this letter we are probably somewhere between Papua New Guinea and America.

For over a year and a half now Michelle has been in pain. Last June we were finally able to get a diagnosis—Fibromyalgia—but not much in the way of treatment. Because of this and other reasons it was decided that we should go on an early furlough.

How long this furlough

will last depends on several things. First, of course, are the medical issues. Also, because this is a furlough, the plan is to return for a full three-year term.

Therefore we'll need to buy supplies and raise more monthly support. That could take a while.

Ultimately though, God is in control.

He will provide the medical help we need, and He will provide the support we need. And, He will bring us back in His time.

After our medical issues are dealt with we can begin looking towards the future. Before we left, we visited a long-running Bible school with an eye towards a future ministry there. Although it's not definite, God does seem to be moving us in that direction.

The school normally runs at capacity (that's over 70 students!) and I would

work alongside several nationals as well as one other missionary. The students are hungry to learn God's word and there is little I desire more than to teach it!

This move would involve significant cost so we want to be certain it is where God wants us. But, He will show us the way and He will provide what we need. Our job is simply to
