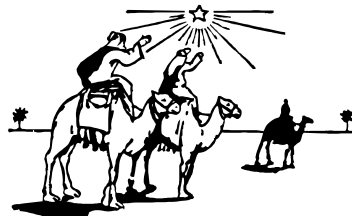
needed to get in the car one more time or the fun we had when we got there.
