This is in addition to making a home in the jungle and home schooling Alicia. Pray that she will learn to manage all of this with minimal stress!
- † Daniel and Stefanie are doing well at school. We miss them but they love all the activities and friends they have there. They are also in an environment geared towards learning. Pray that they will continue to grow "in favor with God [spiritually] and man [character and academics]."
