That's what I said when we started the process of moving to Ukarumpa, and I was right. However, the adventure seems to be that of a ping-pong ball. I've already been back and forth to CLTC twice to work on copiers. Next month I'll go back to teach at CLTC

for 7 weeks with a couple trips back and forth to Ukarumpa for a visit. Next year I'll likely be back and forth to CLTC again to teach yet another course. Many volleys in table tennis end faster than that! Travel isn't cheap but in this country, it's likely to be an adventure!
